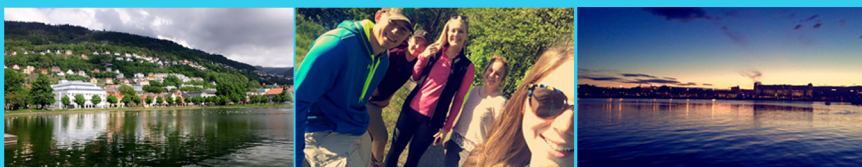
COURSES

ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES OF THE 21ST CENTURY - 3 CREDITS

This course is designed primarily for non-science majors with an interest in the relationship between humans and our environment. We will spend time during this course on building your fundamental knowledge of science and nature and will explore controversial issues such as global climate change, genetically modified foods, water scarcity, energy demands, environmental pollutants and other pertinent issues.

What makes a city a city? Why do cities look the way they do? What makes one city different from another? What can you learn about a people, a country, a culture, by studying one of its major cities? How do cities help us understand the truth and reality behind human behaviors?
